



## CATHOLIC MEMORIAL SULLIVAN CAMPUS RULES OF USE

The following Catholic Memorial Athletics Sullivan Campus Policies and Rules of Use (“Rules of Use”), as amended from time-to-time, will apply to all Applicants, their representatives, participants, invitees, and guests. Any violation of these policies or Rules of Use may result in the group being prohibited from future use of Catholic Memorial Athletics facilities.

- Campus Hours: 7:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. No game may begin before 8:00 a.m., nor start after 8:00 p.m. No new inning may start after 10:00 p.m. **Campus opens at 7am and no one is allowed on the premises before 7am.**
- No smoking or other drug use is permitted on the Premises. Alcohol usage/consumption is not allowed at Catholic Memorial Sullivan Campus. The use of tobacco products is not permitted in buildings or on the grounds.
- Carry-in food and beverages are not allowed, except for bottled water. Bottled water brought on to the Sullivan Campus must have an unbroken seal at time of entry. If unapproved food/drink is brought in, teams may be asked to leave the Premises. Team coolers are acceptable but MUST remain in the team dugout through the entirety of stay at the Campus.
- No dogs/pets are allowed at the Sullivan Campus unless documented service animals.
- All vehicles must park in designated parking areas only. No parking on the grass or by the NX Level building. All vehicles must be legally parked in parking spaces or on the street.
- All trash and recycling must be placed in appropriate receptacles and cleaned up.
- **NO GUM OR SEEDS. No food or sports drinks on turf.**
- **NO METAL CLEATS – Molded cleats, turf shoes or athletic shoes only. (Only exception to this is if playing on Field #5)**
- Batting or throwing practices directed into fences at the Sullivan Campus is not allowed. Damage to the fields or fences from this activity will be repaired and charged to the team for the expenses incurred.



- Warm up areas will be towards the SW corner of the facility. There are other areas that are smaller but very limited on space inside the complex.
- **DO NOT CROSS ON THE SOCCER FIELD BETWEEN #2 and #3. YOU MUST USE PATHWAYS!!** If caught doing so you will be asked to leave the facility
- If CMH needs to repair turf or clean up seeds or gum, the teams will be billed for damages and/or labor.
- Teams are responsible for their own First Aid supplies.
- Athletes and spectators shall not enter any part of the Sullivan Campus property other than the designated Premises.
- Groups are responsible for their own First Aid supplies.
- All athletic field maintenance (i.e. raking, lining, alterations, and additions of material) must be completed by staff personnel only.
- All portable objects such as chairs, tents, etc. shall be removed immediately following the event.
- No weapons, open flames, or flammable or toxic substances shall be brought onto or into the Sullivan Campus.
- Participants, invitees, and guests, including without limitation athletes and coaches shall follow all written, posted, and verbal instructions given by staff.
- In the event of an emergency, the Everyone is expected to cooperate with staff efforts and is responsible for making its invitees and players aware of the Sullivan Campus emergency response plan.
- **All athletic field maintenance (i.e. raking, lining, alterations, and additions of material) must be completed by CMH personnel.**
