



ENG Sports Invitational Rules

Format	Teams are in bracket play or pool play, based on number of available teams.
Rosters	Scoresheets should be filled out with full name and number of each player and turned in at least 10 minutes prior to game time.
Game Length	4 – 8 minute stop clock quarters (8th-12th grade) 4 – 7 minute stop clock quarters for (5th-7th grade)
Warm-Up	At least five (5) minutes per game
Halftime	Four (4) minutes
Running Clock	If at any point during the contest the scoring margin exceeds twenty-five (25) points the clock will revert to running time. The clock will return to a stopped clock with the deficit going below fifteen (15) points.
Timeouts	Two (2) full (60) second timeouts, and one (1) thirty (30) second timeouts
Overtime	Two (2) minute period. Both teams get ONE (1) thirty (30) second timeout. Time outs do not roll over.
Bonus Shots	Teams will shoot two shots after the seventh (7th) foul of each quarter. Team fouls will reset after each quarter.
Player Foul Limit	Six (6) per player
Ball Advancement	The team can advance the ball on their own timeout under 59.9 (seconds) in the 4th quarter after a made basket or gain of possession. (It cannot be advanced after a dribble/pass.)
Home/Visitor Uniforms	The bottom is home and wears a lighter colored jersey; Top is away and wears dark colored jersey.
Game Ball	The game ball will be provided. Teams are responsible for bringing their own basketballs for warm-ups.
With Shot Clock	Will play with NFHS rules and a thirty (30) second shot clock. Rules will be posted at table.
Without Shot Clock	Will play with modified NCAA Rules without a 30-second shot clock. There is a 10-second backcourt. 5-second calls apply with dribbling closely guarded and on held ball.
Technical Fouls	If the coach gets 1 technical, they can still stand. After the 2nd technical, the coach will have to leave the court areas.
Protest	No protest will be allowed for this tournament.
