Coaches codes of conduct:

UPTOWN SPORTS tournaments strictly prohibit fighting and aggressive behavior, aiming to ensure a safe, respectful environment for youth athletes. Violations often lead to immediate removal from the venue and team disqualification.

- Zero Tolerance for Violence:

Physical altercations, fighting, or bullying between parents, coaches, players, or officials are strictly prohibited.

- Zero Tolerance for Abuse:

Verbal abuse, threatening language, and profanity aimed at referees, coaches, or other spectators are forbidden.

- No Interference:

Parents must not interfere with the game, which includes not going onto the court or approaching the score table.

- Coaches Attire :

Coaches are encouraged to wear team attire, colors, or polo shirt.

- Player Supervision

Players should be supervised at all times by guardian or coach over 21.

Accountability:

Coaches are responsible for their actions and those of their guests. Consequences for Violations Immediate Removal & Disqualification: Fights or physical altercations will result in the immediate removal of the responsible party and disqualification of their entire team.

No Refunds:

Teams and parents forfeit all registration fees and tournament costs if disqualified due to code of conduct violations
